

Dr. Deutsch is a Professor in the School of Mining and Petroleum Engineering, Department of Civil & Environmental Engineering at the University of Alberta. He teaches and conducts research into better ways to model heterogeneity and uncertainty in petroleum reservoirs and mineral deposits. Prior to joining the University of Alberta, Dr. Deutsch was an Associate Professor (Research) in the Department of Petroleum Engineering at Stanford University and Director of the Stanford Center for Reservoir Forecasting (SCRF). His employment history also includes three years with Exxon Production Research Company as a Research Specialist in the Reservoir Division and three years of experience with Placer Dome Inc. conducting ore reserve valuations. Dr. Deutsch has published two books, over 45 peer-reviewed technical papers, and over 40 papers in conference proceedings.
