Please note the following extract from the GAA Constitution:

2.1.1 Member

Individuals may become a *Member* of the Association on application, subject to approval being granted by the Executive Committee. Members of the Association shall normally have professional qualifications in mathematics, geosciences, engineering, environmental sciences or other relevant discipline and have a significant portion of their professional activity related to geostatistics, but not necessarily be specialised geostatisticians. In this constitution, "Member" specifically denotes this grade of membership, whereas "member" is a generic term covering any or all grades defined herein.

2.1.2 Associate Member

Individuals may become an *Associate Member* of the Association on application, subject to approval being granted by the Executive Committee. Associate Members of the Association may not have a significant portion of their professional activity related to geostatistics, as stipulated for Member status.

2.1.3 Student Member

Individuals may become a *Student Member* of the Association on application, subject to approval being granted by the Executive Committee. Student Members of the Association must annually provide documentary proof of full-time enrolment in a recognised undergraduate or graduate program in a discipline within which geostatistics has application.
